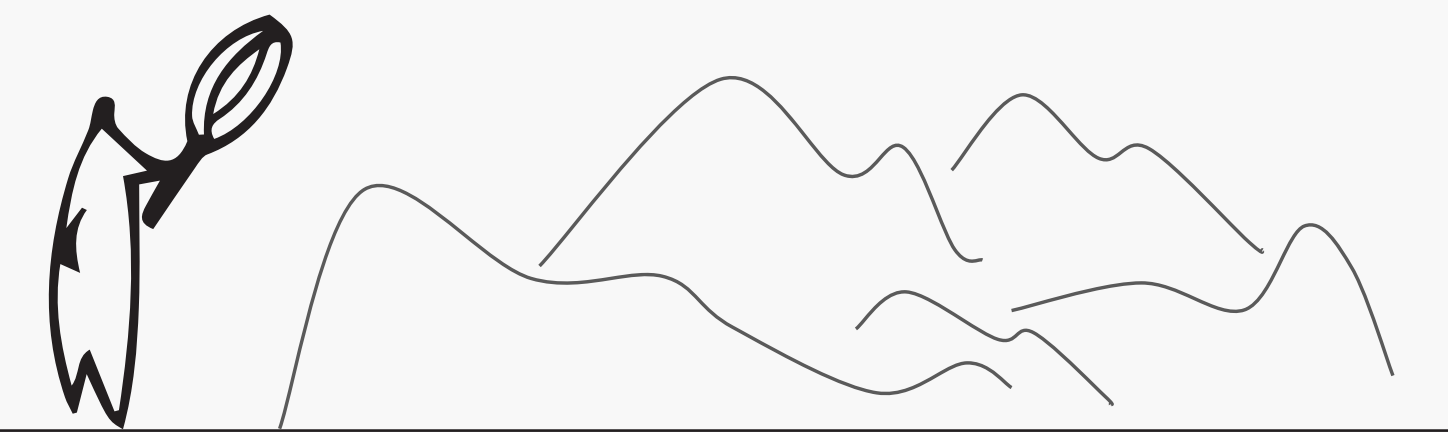


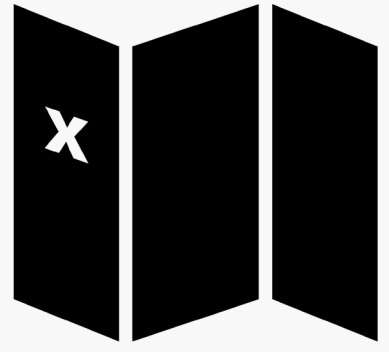
Prague Hillsides

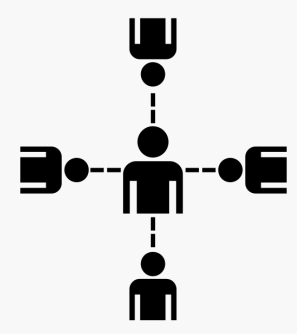
Scenario

Actors



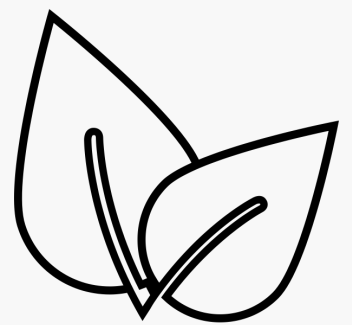
- Many stakeholders are involved in the areas. They can have different, even conflicting, interests on various aspects concerning the governance of the area. Cooperation between the actors can be useful to achieve an integrated approach.

Management



- Management and maintenance in the area could ensure the accessibility of and the mobility within the area. Furthermore facilities like pathways, benches and fences and the vegetation need to be managed and maintained.

Green



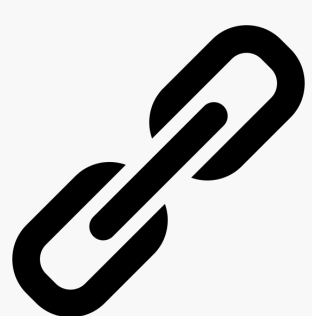
- The hillsides offer a range of ecosystem services on different spatial scales. Services include the materials and energy obtained from the ecosystem, like food and water. It also includes the environment for flora and fauna. Other kind of services are, for example, regulation of air and water quality by the ecosystem. The opportunities provided by the ecosystem for human use, as tourism and recreation, is also part of these services.

Safety



- Safety on the hillsides is an important issue and consists of two categories. First, there is the physical safety that includes the condition of pathways and other facilities in the area. Secondly, there is the perceived safety by the people about the area and its inhabitants.

Connectivity



- Connectivity relates to the overall picture of the five areas discussed. The different hillsides are connected to each other, and should create an overall system that supports the human use as well as the nature inside the areas.
